





Turtle Ranger Programme

- The Turtle Ranger Programme offers guests an opportunity to engage directly in a range of conservation initiatives. These activities include safeguarding turtle nests, aiding young turtles on their voyage from nest to sea, and gathering essential photo face ID tracking data to oversee their migration routes. To date, the program has successfully released more than 500 baby turtles into the ocean.
- In addition to their conservation efforts, Turtle Rangers also play an active role in conducting workshops within the Sustainability Lab. Here, they transform plastic debris collected during beach cleaning events into turtle-shaped products using the lab's specialized plastic recycling machines. This multi-faceted approach not only contributes to turtle conservation but also promotes environmental awareness and sustainable practices.

• The most frequently used currency is the US dollar and all traded items are priced in dollars. Other accepted currencies include Australian, Singapore and Canadian Dollars, Japanese Yen, Euro and the British Pound, according to Maldivian Monetary Authority exchange rates. The Maldives has its own currency called "Rufiyaa" (MVR) but the resort accepts credit cards from American Express, Visa and MasterCard.
